



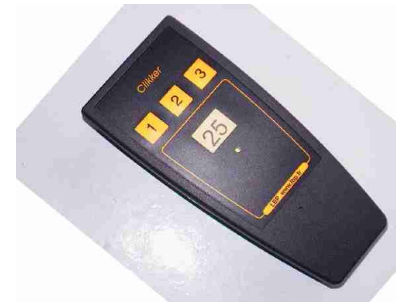
CLikker: wireless electronic bidding for CLOCK auction sales



Sales software adapted to the product at the request of the operator. Progressive, degressive or combined sales

A fully transportable kit for auction sales operations

A Panel or a portable computer, an electronic display or a projector and a screen, and the wireless "clikker" bidding machines by LBP.



Bbox: wireless electronic bidding for sales by tender and adjudication

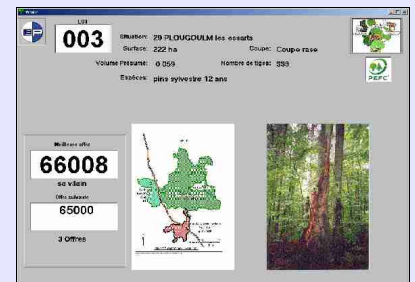
Bid auction box, wireless version, with radio module, no need for a license, 16-key keypad, 2 x 16-character line screen, memory card reader, battery pack included, minimum 15 hours autonomy, - 1 case and 1 charger for 20 boxes.

Dimensions 200 mm* 100 mm * 40 mm – black ABS case - Lexan façade with customer logo and instructions.

Can be used with voting or quiz software for professional training.

A single receiver manages several hundred boxes within a radius of 50m without obstacle, the system is insensitive to mobile telephone interference. – voting time for 100 boxes: less than 4 seconds. – Serial or USB link with a fixed or portable PC

Comes with software enabling general display on screen using a projector connected to the control PC, with projection of detailed data, an IGN map, and a photo. Auction mode and presentation of the results according to operator criteria: lower bids, withdrawal price, etc.



Advantages of these wireless tools:

- Saves time for the organiser. Tool transportable in a car
- Automatic print-outs after the sale.
- Simple to operate by the buyer.
- Fast sales without delay.
- Perfect fairness, in the auction room and remotely.
- Reduced maintenance.
